Date	Area	Treatment Done:
Jan 2019	Building 1 – Acacia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All boxes were checked for activity / We have noticed an increase of activity at this building</li> </ul>
	Building 2 – Baobab	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All rodent bait stations had to be re-baited due to the snail infestation at this building. We will treat the effected boxes for snails.</li> </ul>
	Building 3 – Coral	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The activity at this building has decreased, although we had to rebait the boxes in the middle at the stairs</li> </ul>
	Building 4 – Flamethorn	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All boxes were checked / The activity is still manageable at this stage.</li> </ul>
	Building 5 – Dombeya	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All boxes were checked and some were re-baited / We did find some snail activity in some of the boxes. This will cause the rodent infestation to increase / We will still monitor this area closely.</li> </ul>
	Building 6 – Gardenia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All boxes were checked / Rodent activity increased due to the snail infestation at this building</li> </ul>
	Building 7 – Ebony	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All boxes were checked and re-baited / There was an increase in activity, but is still manageable at this stage.</li> </ul>
	Refuse area	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All boxes were checked and re-baited</li> <li>Increased rodent activity detected in the main refuse area only due to the refuse bags not being taken away immediately</li> </ul>

Area	Findings
Refuse area	In general we found an increase of activity in this area. This area will be monitored closely with each visit, as the rodents are attracted to the refuse.
Buildings 1 – 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In general there was a decrease in rodent activity in the complex. However, we did notice a large amount of ants marching up to the units at each building. The tenants / owners are welcome to contact us if they need us to come through and treat their units</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We have also found a big increase of snail activity at some of the buildings. We will be spraying poison at the effected boxes only.</li></ul>
General findings	Just a reminder, with regards the rodent boxes that need to be re-installed and replaced, please can you advise the cleaning staff not to move or damage the boxes, as this will cause an increase of rodent activity.
